TO PROVIDE DENTAL SUPPLIES FOR TRAINING OF TANZANIAN DENTAL THERAPY
STUDENTS IN PREVENTIVE SCHOOL-BASED OUTREACH**

Access to dental supplies needed for teaching the students how to set up and implement effective school-based programs is unreliable.

”Seventy percent of Tanzanians live in rural communities with little to no oral healthcare access,” said Dr. Bergman, Director of MCW Healthcare Projects. “Preventive care is key to improving oral health, particularly in resource-poor settings. Our focus is on helping the dental therapy schools train their students on how to set up school-based preventive oral health programs so they can do this effectively once they graduate and are deployed to the regions.” With the help of Henry Schein Cares, access to health care for underserved

and at risk populations around the world in the areas of wellness, prevention, treatment and education, emergency preparedness and relief, and capacity building is possible.
