Main Purpose and Scope of the Job:

This internship focuses on actively contributing to the creation of the Well-Rounded Pathways Curriculum at Miracle Corners Rwanda (MCR). The intern will play a key role in integrating vocational training, soft skills development, and healthcare awareness sessions into a comprehensive educational program for youth with vulnerable backgrounds. Over four months, the intern will collaborate closely with the team to craft a holistic curriculum aimed at empowering participants for successful transitions to employment or self-employment after their education.

Role Description

Main Roles and Responsibilities:

Contributing to the curriculum integration

- Collaborate closely with the program team to consolidate existing vocational training modules into the Well-rounded Pathways Curriculum, ensuring seamless integration and alignment.
- Assist in organizing and compiling already existing soft skills content, including leadership and entrepreneurship modules, into a cohesive program tailored to the target audience's needs.
- Work alongside young healthcare professionals to gather, compile, and refine content for healthcare life skills sessions, emphasizing practical applications within the Well-rounded Pathways Curriculum.

Curriculum Development Support

- Participate actively in the development of practical sessions and activities that enhance the vocational, soft skills, and healthcare life skills components within the Well-rounded Pathways Curriculum.
- Contribute ideas and assist in structuring the curriculum to facilitate a smooth transition for participants toward employment or self-employment after completion of their education.



Collaboration and Teamwork

- Engage with the program team and young leaders brought on board by MCR to ensure seamless integration and coherence across all disciplines within the Well-rounded Pathways Curriculum.
- Actively participate in brainstorming sessions and knowledge-sharing activities to enhance the overall effectiveness of the curriculum.

Documentation and Reporting

- Guided by the program team, maintain detailed records of the curriculum integration and development process.
- Produce bi-weekly progress reports and update the team on the development progress.

- Must be a Young Leaders Program (YLP) Alumni with a bachelor's degree in Education, Social Sciences, or a related field.
- Must have basic experience or exposure to content creation, curriculum development, or educational program management.
- Must be proficient in Microsoft Office Suite.
- Should have good communication and interpersonal skills for effective collaboration.
- Must be available for the full internship period from June to October 30, 2024.
- Prior experience in community initiatives and development projects is an added advantage
- Must be well aware of MCW Global's vision, mission, and programs.
